

**To CNA Surety Producers Writing Contract  
Bonds on Jobs Located in Kentucky**

As you may know, for years Kentucky has allowed local governments such as counties and municipalities to collect a tax on insurance premiums. Beginning January 1, 2010, Kentucky has added some additional requirements; one of these relevant to contract bonds is that actual physical job site location must be collected in order for the surety to remit the tax to the appropriate jurisdiction.

Beginning immediately, please include this information with all contract bond submissions to us. What is needed is the physical job site location, which may be different from an owner's or obligee's address. Per Kentucky's requirements, the local government premium tax on contract bonds is based upon job site location. Therefore, please include the specific location of the job site in every submission to us.

For the time being, as before, CNA Surety will not be collecting this additional tax from our principals and insureds. In order to do so, a number of additional requirements must be met, and we are reviewing those requirements at this time. When we are ready and able to invoice and collect these taxes, we will communicate with you in advance of releasing that process.
